ACCOMODATIONS

Lake Comedero Lodge, nestled between the Sierra Madre Mountains, is located in the small village of "Vertedore", and sits near the "Presidente Jose' Lopez Portillo Dam". The 1440 square foot lodge offers spacious comfort and a relaxing environment. The great room is an open room equipped with a grand dining area, flanked by a fully stocked bar and a game table for your entertainment. A large TV/DVD is surrounded by water features and tropical plants giving this room the ambiance needed to complete its look. To give the lodge the authentic Spanish feel, the 720 square foot veranda has large Mexican leather rockers and woven hammocks for enjoying the starry night or that first cup of coffee in the brisk morning air.



Our guest rooms, located directly behind the lodge, are equipped with two double beds and each has private baths. The rooms are tastefully decorated and totally furnished to give you a peaceful nights sleep and the privacy you deserve. The entire lodge and quarters are surrounded by an eight foot fence that is set off by a brick and iron entrance wall.

Purified water is available in each room for your personal needs. All water used in the lodge for cooking, drinking and ice is purified water.



YOUR ARRIVAL

In preparing for your trip to Lake Comedero Lodge, you will find several airlines available with daily flights into Mazatlan. RESERVATIONS AND POLICIES

Reservations at Lake Comedero Lodge require a 50%, non-refundable deposit per client and should arrive at our office within five working days after your date has been reserved. We will hold your reservation on a temporary basis, awaiting your deposit.

If your deposit is not received, we will cancel your reservation and reopen those dates for other bookings. After your deposit is received, we will send you a complete vacation packet, which will include the information about your trip along with your receipt and confirmation number. Please be sure to retain this number. It will be needed for your pick-up at the airport and for any future correspondence with Lake Comedero Lodge.

The remainder of your fee must be paid sixty days prior to your arrival. This fee becomes non-refundable if cancellation occurs within thirty days of your scheduled arrival. BOATS & GUIDES

Our boats, at Lake Comedero Lodge, are fully equipped Pro Team 175 Tracker Bass boats with live wells, front, center and back swivel seats, and trolling motors with deep-cycle batteries. Each boat will be stocked with nets, scales, tape measures, a log sheet, to record the days catch, along with beverages for the day's trip. We suggest you take your camera, to capture those memorable moments of the day. We will have disposable cameras for sale for your convenience. Should you wish to have mounts made, we recommend replica mounts, made by measurements taken from the log sheets. We are a catch and release lodge, although enough fish will be brought in for meals at the lodge.



Our guides are local fishermen and many have fished this lake since they were old enough to paddle a boat. They know the exact layout of the lake and the hotspots therein. Even though they are Spanish spoken, they have learned to communicate quite well with our American guest. Their job is to accommodate our clients with their fishing needs and to show them three great days of fishing. Their humorous, yet respectful, personalities are sure to make your day on the lake comfortable, relaxing and hopefully rewarding.
